Kevin Kowalski is a High School Ceramic teacher at Esparanza High School in Anaheim, CA. He has been working in ceramics since his junior year of high school and went on to get his BFA in Ceramics and his BA in Art Education at Cal State Fullerton.

Join us for an afternoon of watching, learning and experimenting with Kevin Kowalski. Kevin will be sharing his wheel throwing skills along with instructions for how to decorate these forms using a mocha diffusion technique he has been experimenting with. What is Mocha Diffusion?

As described in Kevin's website, Mocha Diffusion is the interaction of an acid on top of a wet alkaline clay slip surface. A thick slip is applied over leather hard work. While still wet, a mixture of stain and an acidic agent such as vinegar, soy sauce or alcohol is dropped onto the surface with a brush which immediately creates the bursts of color. The piece is then left to dry, bisque fired and then finished with a transparent glaze or soda fired.
